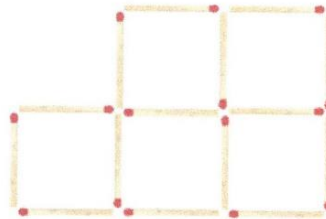

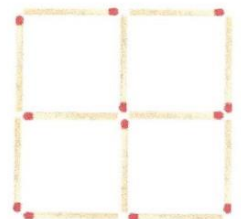
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Matchstick Puzzles - #1

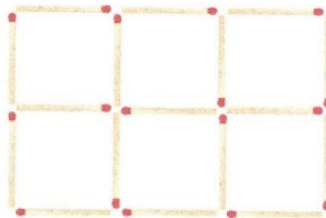
1. Leave just three squares by removing three matchsticks.



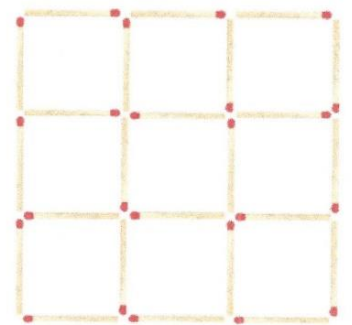
4. Leave just two squares by removing two matchsticks.



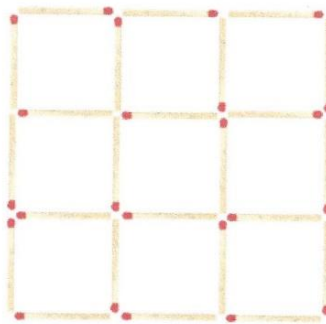
2. Leave just three squares by removing five matchsticks.
